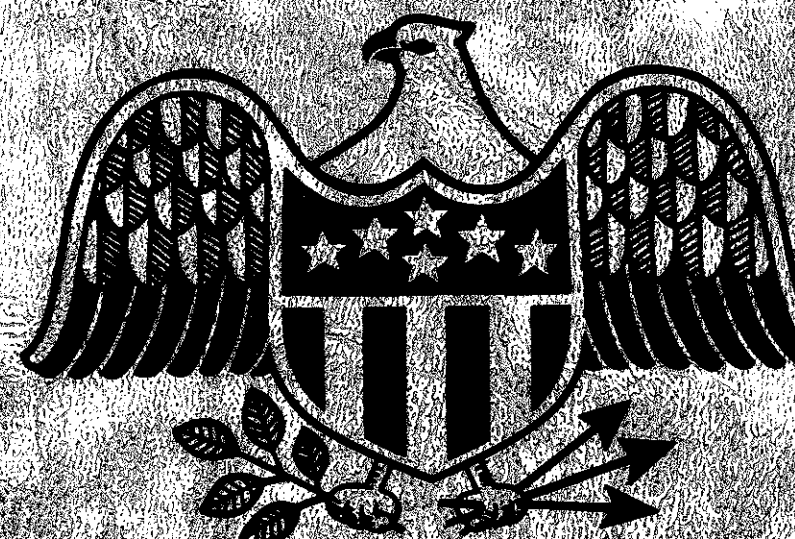

FOREWORD

In this election year's edition of the Official Results of the 1982 General Election we have included a new statistical chart on Page 21 showing (according to the most recent census figures) the percentages of those eligible to vote who actually voted and those registered to vote who actually voted. These figures have been broken down into the political geographical areas most used in Delaware as boundaries.

In comparing these statistics with those of the 1978 election which was also a non-presidential year election, we find that we have improved our percentage of those eligible to register who are actually registered from 65.7% in 1978 to 67% in 1982 -- also we increased the percentage of those registered to vote who actually voted from 60% in 1978 to 68% in 1982 -- and also increased the percentage of those eligible to vote who actually voted from 40% in 1978 to 46% in 1982.

All of these increases are hopeful indications that the interest in participating in elections by the eligible citizens of Delaware is in the upswing. However, the basis of all increases is more registration of those 142,007 unregistered eligibles. In order to reach a 80% registration, we need to register 56,458 more eligibles. Traditionally, about 15,000 more will register for the Presidential year general elections. Extra efforts will be needed to register the remaining 40,000 to achieve a goal of 80%.

Governor - Must be 30 years of age and a citizen and resident of the U.S. for 12 years; must have been a resident of Delaware six years prior to his election, unless absent on public business of the U.S. or of the State.

Lt. Governor - Same as above.

U.S. Senator - Must have attained the age of 30 and 9 years as a citizen of the U.S. and a resident when chosen of the State he represents.

U.S. House of Representatives - Must be at least 25 years of age; 7 years a citizen of the U.S., and at the time of his election an inhabitant of the State he represents.

Attorney General - Must be a qualified elector at the time of his election.

Insurance Commissioner - Must be a qualified elector at the time of his election.

Auditor of Accounts - Must be a qualified elector at the time of his election.

State Treasurer - Must be a qualified elector at the time of his election.

State Senator - Must be 27 years of age and must have been a citizen and inhabitant of the State three years next preceding the day of his election and the last year of that term an inhabitant of the Senatorial District in which he shall be chosen, unless he shall have been absent on the public business of the United States or of this State.

State Representative - Must be 24 years of age and must have been a citizen and inhabitant of the State three years next preceding the day of his election and the last year of that term an inhabitant of the Representative District in which he shall be chosen, unless he shall have been absent on the public business of the United States or of this State.

CITY OF WILMINGTON

Mayor - Must be a resident of the city for at least 5 years preceding his election and shall be at least 30 years of age at time of election.

City Councilman - Must be a citizen of the United States and shall be a qualified elector of the city at least 1 year prior to his election; shall hold no other city office while elected to City Council; he shall not be less than 25 years of age when elected to office; shall remain a resident of the district during term of office.

City Treasurer - Must be a citizen of the U.S. and a resident of the city at the time of election and remain such during his tenure.

NEW CASTLE COUNTY

New Castle County Executive - Must be 27 years of age, a citizen of the U.S. and a resident of New Castle County for 5 years and a qualified elector of New Castle County.

President of County Council - Must be a citizen of the U.S. and a qualified elector of the County; must not be less than 24 years of age when elected to office.

STATE OF DELAWARE

NEW CASTLE COUNTY (Continued)

County Councilmen - Shall be citizen of U.S. and a qualified elector of New Castle County; he shall be a resident of the district from which he is elected for 1 year and must not be less than 24 years of age at time of election.

Prothonotary - Must be qualified to vote for the most numerous branch of the Legislature. Shall be 21 years of age and a resident of the State and County for 1 year prior to his election.

Clerk of Peace - Same as above.

Register of Wills - Same as above.

Recorder of Deeds - Same as above.

Register in Chancery - Same as above.

Sheriff - Same as above; also no person may be elected a sheriff twice in any term of 4 years.

KENT COUNTY

Levy Court Commissioner - Must be a resident and freeholder of his respective district and a qualified elector.

Clerk of the Peace - Must be qualified to vote for the most numerous branch of the Legislature; must be 21 years of age and a resident of the county for 1 year prior to election.

Prothonotary - Same as above.

Register of Wills - Same as above.

Recorder of Deeds - Same as above.

Register in Chancery - Same as above.

Receiver of Taxes and County Treasurer - Must be qualified to vote for members of the General Assembly and must be a resident of the county.

County Comptroller - Must be qualified to vote for members of the General Assembly and be a resident and freeholder in the county for which he is Comptroller.

SUSSEX COUNTY

County Councilman - Must be a citizen of the U.S. and a qualified elector of the county and a resident of the district from which he is elected 1 year prior to his election.

Register of Wills - Must be qualified to vote for the most numerous branch of the Legislature. Should be 21 years of age and a resident of the state and county for 1 year prior to his election.

Recorder of Deeds - Same as above.

Register of Chancery - Same as above.

Clerk of the Peace - Must be qualified to vote for the most numerous branch of the Legislature; must be 21 years of age and a resident of the county for 1 year prior to his election.
