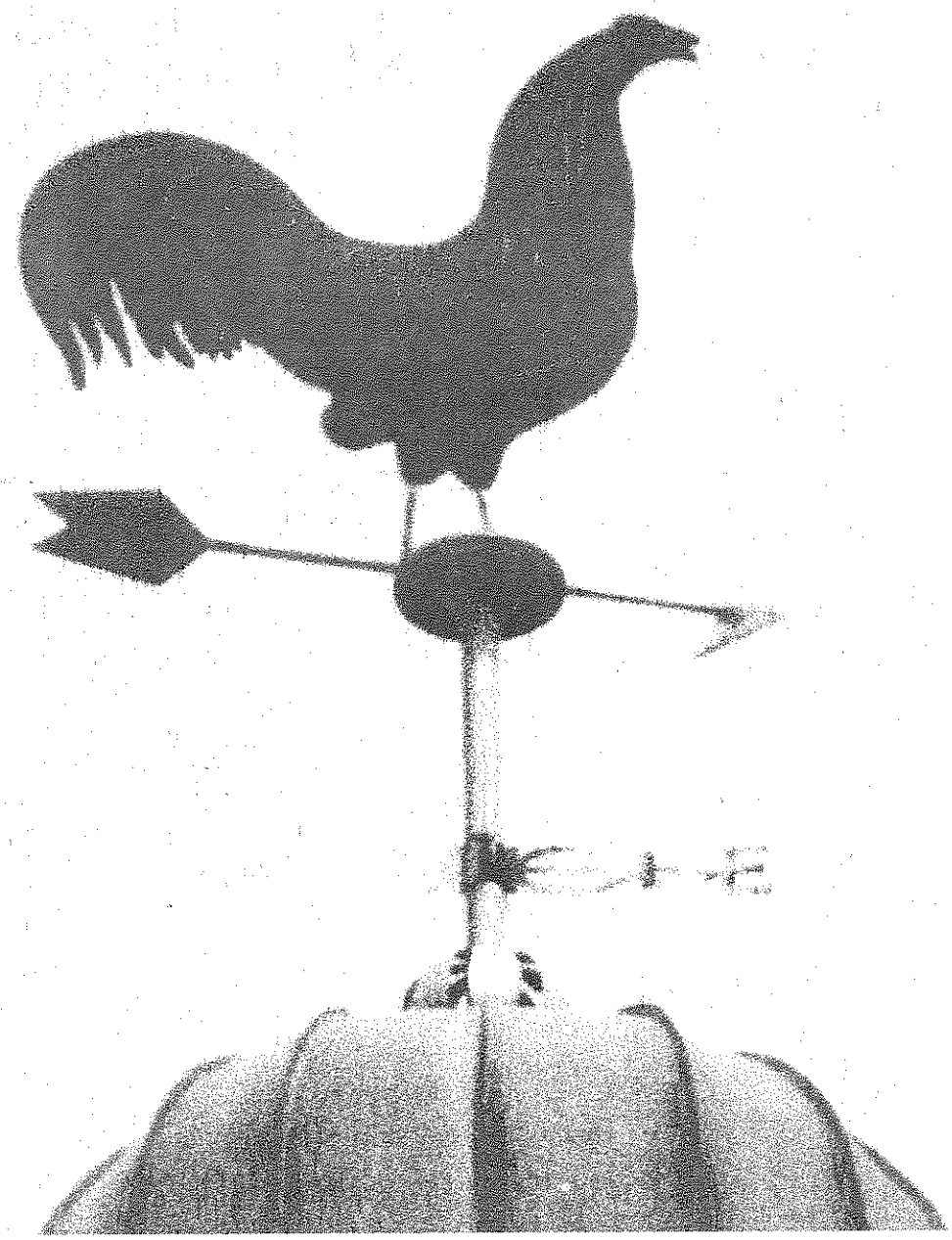


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FORWARD

The right to vote is a privilege granted to us by our forefathers. Without this voice in democracy, the public would not play such a large role in formulation of laws and policies for this country. In 1994, 58% of the registered voters cast their vote in the General Election.

The following pages represent results from the 1994 election cycle. In 1994, the state of Delaware lost a long time state senator and champion of human rights, Herman M. Holloway Sr., to a battle with cancer. His death created a widely publicized special election of which the results are also contained within this publication.

Also in 1994 Delaware's "Agency Based Registration" law went into effect. This allows the public to register to vote at the Division of Motor Vehicles, Department of Health and Social Services and the Department of Labor in addition to the service already provided by the Department of Elections. The end result was over 40,000 new voters added to the election rolls. Even with this ability to reach out to the different sectors of the public, it still must be each citizen's responsibility to exercise his or her right to vote.

State Senator - Must be 27 years of age and must have been a citizen and inhabitant of the State three years next preceding the day of his election and the last year of that term an inhabitant of the Senatorial District in which he shall be chosen, unless he shall have been absent on the public business of the U.S. or of this State. (Art. II, § 3 State Constitution)

State Representative - Must be 24 years of age and must have been a citizen and inhabitant of the State three years next preceding the day of his election and the last year of that term an inhabitant of the Representative District in which he shall be chosen, unless he shall have been absent on the public business of the U.S. or of this State. (Art. II, § 3 State Constitution)

CITY OF WILMINGTON

Mayor - Must be a resident of the city for at least 2 years preceding election and shall be at least 30 years of age at the time of election, and remain a resident during term of office. (Section 3-300, City of Wilmington Charter)
