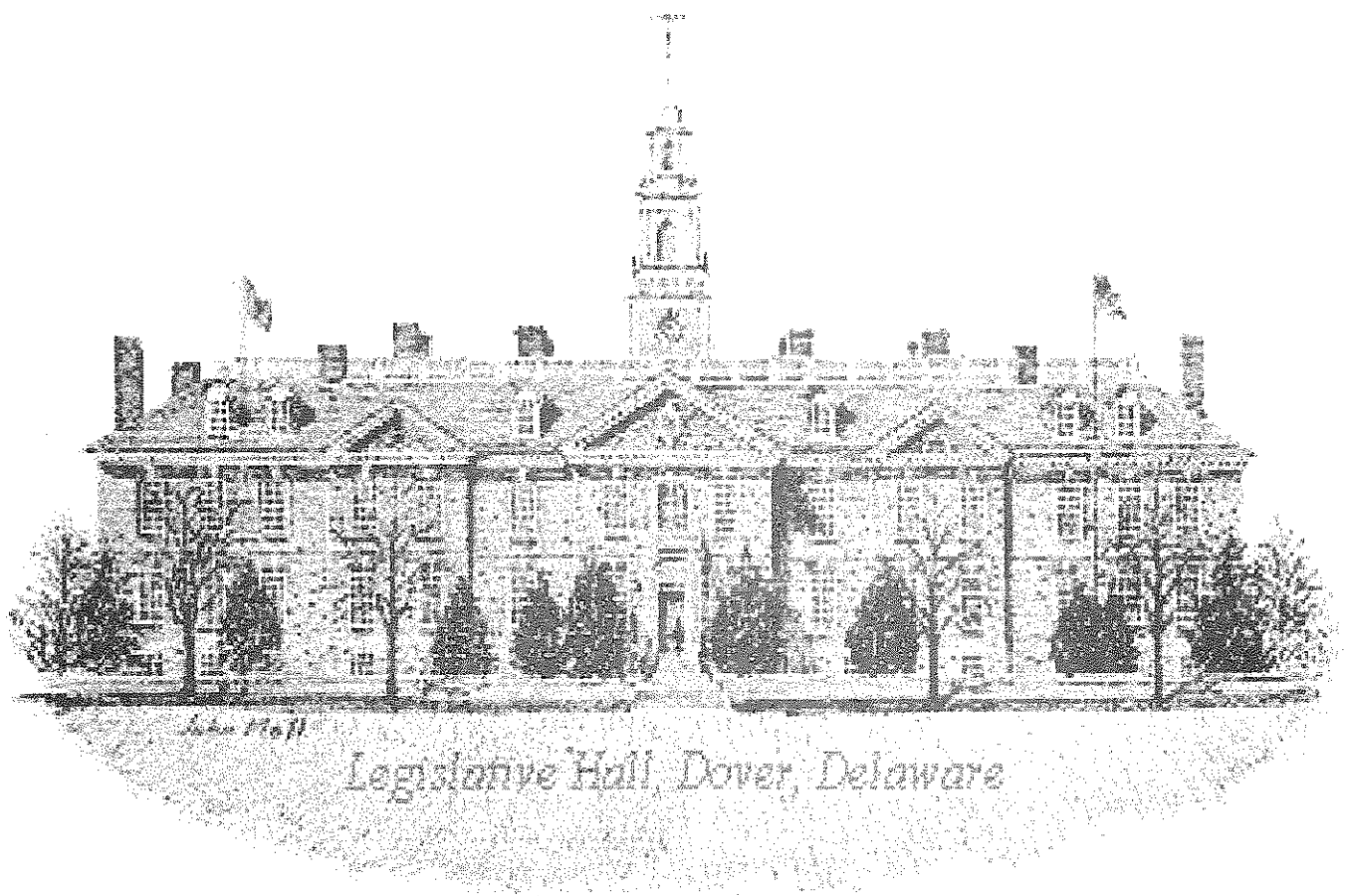


# State of Delaware

## Forward

*The State of Delaware is appropriately nicknamed "The First State" because it was the first state in the nation to ratify the United States Constitution. In 1996, Delaware became the "First State in Elections." February 24, 1996, Delaware held its first ever Presidential Primary. May 11, 1996, Delaware held its first ever "electronic voting machine election" in the first town established in Delaware, Lewes. On July 1, 1996, for the first time ever, the number of registered voters in Delaware eclipsed the 400,000 mark. September 7, 1996, Delaware conducted its first ever state election using electronic voting machines. And finally, November 5, 1996, Delaware became the "First State in the Nation" to conduct an all electronic voting machine constitutional election.*

*The following pages represent results from 1996 election cycle. Also included are the election results from a special election held in the late summer of 1995 for the 1st Representative District, in which Orlando J. George, Jr., stepped down from that position to become President of Delaware Technical and Community College. On a sad note, another special election took place in November of 1995, when the citizens of Kent County lost a well respected Levy Court Commissioner named Pat Lynn due to a battle with cancer. The results of that election are also contained within this publication.*

*In closing, it should be noted that once again the State of Delaware cast its electoral votes for the successful presidential candidate. But, even though the voter registration rolls soared to an all-time high in 1996, the actual number of people casting their ballots was less than the number of people in 1992. As citizens of this great state take pride in having access to their elected officials, it is extremely important that the right to vote, as granted to us by our forefathers, be exercised on election day.*

**U.S. House of Representatives** - Must be at least 25 years of age; 7 years a citizen of the U.S.; and at the time of election an inhabitant of the State he represents. (Art I, § 3 U.S. Constitution)

**Attorney General** - Must be a qualified elector at the time of his election.

**Insurance Commissioner** - Must be a qualified elector at the time of his election.

**Auditor of Accounts** - Must be a qualified elector at the time of his election.

**State Treasurer** - Must be a qualified elector at the time of his election.
