## \*Write-In Totals are the sum of:

- 1. Write-in votes for candidates on the ballot: These votes are added to the candidate's official vote total.
- 2. Write-in votes for **Other** individuals: These votes are for people who are not on the ballot and are not registered as declared write-in candidates, in accordance with Delaware Code, Title 15, Section 3402(b).
- \*\*No Declared Write-In Candidates. Per Delaware Code, all write-in votes for individuals other than Declared Write-In Candidates are recorded as "Other Write-In Votes" (Delaware Code, Title 15, Section 3402(b)).
- \*\*\*An overvote occurs when a voter makes more than the maximum number of choices allowed in an election. (NOTE: This may only occur on an absentee ballot. An overvote is not possible on the voting machines used in polling places.)
- \*\*\*\*An undervote occurs when a voter makes fewer than the maximum number of choices allowed in an election. An undervote also occurs when a voter makes no choice in a single-choice election.
