Are you unable to vote at the polls for the City of Dover Regular Municipal Election on Tuesday, April 20, 2021? Any qualified elector, duly registered, may cast their vote by ABSENTEE BALLOT. To see if you are qualified to vote absentee and to obtain a Request for an Absentee Ballot form, please call the City Clerk's Office at 736-7008.

Once completed, the request form can be emailed to <a href="cityclerk@dover.de.us">cityclerk@dover.de.us</a>; mailed to City Clerk, P.O. Box 475, Dover, DE 19903; or hand delivered to the City Clerk's Office at 15 Loockerman Plaza, Dover, DE 19901. If you choose to deliver your completed Request form in person, you will be permitted to cast your absentee ballot at the time of delivery.

In accordance with Governor Carney's Sixth Modification to the Omnibus State of Emergency, the qualification of "sick or physically disabled" as used in 15 Del. C. §§ 5502(4) and 7571 shall apply to and include any such duly qualified voter who is asymptomatic of COVID-19 infection and/or wishes to self-quarantine or exercise social distancing to avoid potential exposure to (and community spread of) COVID-19, and who herself or himself freely chooses to use such qualification to vote by absentee ballot.
