

Notice of Solicitation for Candidates in the Special 1st District Municipal Election to be held on Wednesday, May 29, 2024

Anyone wishing to be considered as a candidate for the position of Councilperson must file as a candidate for election on forms provided by the Town by no later than 7:00PM on Monday, April 29, 2024.

The forms required for registration as well as the qualifications for this position, are available at the Elsmere Town Hall located at # 11 Poplar Avenue, Elsmere, Delaware 19805.

The office up for election and term for this office is as follows;

1st District Council

(Term Expires May 1, 2025)

Candidate qualifications for the office of Council are as follows:

All Candidates must be a qualified elector of the Town of Elsmere, at least 21 years of age and have lived in the Town of Elsmere for at least one (1) year prior to May 29, 2024, is eligible to file as a candidate for the office of Councilperson; provided that any person elected to the office Council must, at the time of his or her election reside in the district from which elected.

All Candidates filing for office must file a certificate of intention, or a statement of organization, establishing a campaign committee with the State Election Commissioner no later than seven days after declaring their candidacy.

The forms required for registration, as well as the qualifications for each position, are available at the Elsmere Town Hall located at #11 Poplar Avenue Elsmere, Delaware 19805 as well as the Town's website at www.townofelsmere.com.

At the time of filing, a fee of \$60.00 for the office of Councilperson must be paid.

The normal operating hours of the Town Hall are 8:00AM to 4:00PM Monday through Friday except holidays and will be open on April 29, 2024 until 7:00PM.
