



## What are the deadlines?

Important deadlines for voters

DATE	EVENT
May 8, 2020	Last day for registered voters to change their political party affiliation before the Presidential Primary Election. [NOTE: New deadline due to rescheduling of Presidential Primary to July 7, 2020.]
May 29, 2020	Last day for registered voters to change their political party affiliation before the September 15, 2020, Primary Election.
Jun 13, 2020	Last day to register to vote before the July 7, 2020 Presidential Primary election. [NOTE: New deadline due to rescheduling of Presidential Primary to July 7, 2020.]
Jul 3, 2020	The last day that Department of Elections' Offices must mail Presidential Primary Election absentee ballots. [NOTE: New deadline due to rescheduling of Presidential Primary to July 7, 2020.]
Jul 6, 2020 at Noon	The last time that Department of Elections' Offices can issue absentee ballots for the Presidential Primary Election. [NOTE: New deadline due to rescheduling of Presidential Primary to July 7, 2020.]
Jul 7, 2020 at 8 p.m.	Deadline for the Department of Elections office in your county to receive your absentee ballot for the Presidential Primary Election in order for it to be counted. [NOTE: New deadline due to rescheduling of Presidential Primary to July 7, 2020.]
Aug 22, 2020	Deadline for unregistered citizens to register to vote before the September 15, 2020 Primary Election.
Sept 11, 2020	The last day that Department of Elections' Offices must mail Primary Election absentee ballots.
Sep 14, 2020 at Noon	The last time that Department of Elections' Offices can issue absentee ballots for the Primary Election.
Sep 15, 2020 at 8 p.m.	Deadline for the Department of Elections office in your county to receive your absentee ballot for the Primary Election in order for it to be counted.
Oct 10, 2020	Last day to register to vote before the General Election.
Oct 30, 2020	Last day Department of Elections' offices must mail General Election absentee ballots.
Nov 2, 2020 at Noon	The last time that Department of Elections' Offices can issue absentee ballots for the General Election.
Nov 3, 2020 at 8 p.m.	Deadline for the Department's office in your county to receive your absentee ballot for the General Election in order for it to be counted.
