


#### Facilities

    - FY2024 Budget includes funds for exploring potential expansion of facility
    - Negotiations would be led by State Office of Management and Budget/Facilities Management on feasibility/terms of potential expansion
    - Ideal situation would be increase in rent at current lease rate for additional space
