

Audit of the Caesar Rodney Referendum - Machine Audit

On April 28, 2023, at 10:10 a.m., Kent County Director Doris Reed-Young called to order the meeting, which was held at the Kent County Office. The following persons were present at the meeting: Kent County Director Doris Reed-Young, Kent County Deputy Director Ralph Artigliere, and 2 Department of Elections Staff. There were no members of the public present.

During the Certification of the Caesar Rodney Referendum one machine was selected to be audited from the Referendum held on April 22, 2023.

The two election staff members worked as a team to manually recount the ballots to ensure that the number of ballots processed matched the number of activation cards that were present in the secure card containers. Then they manually recounted the number of votes that each selection received to ensure that they matched the machine tape.

The machine was located at Allen Frear Elementary School during the Referendum. The public count of machine number **KC0027** was 177. The total number of votes cast including undervotes equaled 177.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:40 a.m.
