TO AUTHORIZE THE LEVY OF ADDITIONAL TAXES AND THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS

Notice is hereby given that a Special Election will be held on April 22, 2023, in the Caesar Rodney School District ("District") pursuant to resolutions duly adopted on February 28, 2023, by the Board of Education of said school district, in accordance with the provisions of Chapters 10, 19, and 21 of Title 14 of the Delaware Code, in order to permit the voters of the District to vote either for or against each of the Issues described in the following three Sections:

Section 1:

To support renovation of Magnolia Middle School, the Caesar Rodney School District is seeking authority to issue bonds payable to the State of Delaware in the amount of \$2,933,900, payable over 20 years, to be used for funding for planning, constructing, and equipping the following:

- Renovation of Magnolia Middle School, primarily with regard to HVAC system update
- Legal fees, architectural fees, contingencies, and costs of supervision and auditing incidental to and accruing from the renovation of Magnolia Middle School

The bonds represent \$2,933,900 or 21% (Caesar Rodney School District's share) of the total cost of \$13,971,100 for the project listed above.

If the District is authorized to issue bonds for the reasons state above, the District shall levy and collect additional property taxes to provide for the payment of interest and principal on such bonds. Notes regarding this Section 1 table: Estimated "Annual Tax Increase" amounts are rounded and are stated in Cents/\$100 of Assessed Value. The "Annual Tax Rate" is based on the District's current debt service rate (\$0.2500 per \$100 of assessed value) and several other factors including market interest rates. Retirement of existing debt will offset annual tax increases in future years. The calculations in the above table were prepared without regard to any future referenda that may be pursued by the District.

For a property in the District assessed at a value of \$40,300 (Caesar Rodney School District average assessment), the estimated increase in debt service cost to the homeowner effective July 1, 2023 would be \$0.00 per year.

To support District operations at Magnolia Middle and David E. Robinson Elementary Schools, the Caesar Rodney School District is seeking authority to levy and collect the following additional taxes effective July 1, 2023 on all assessed taxable real estate in the District to fund operating expenses associated generally with the recently opened Magnolia Middle and David E. Robinson Elementary Schools as follows: (Note: Amounts of additional taxes proposed in this Section 2 are in addition to the amounts of additional taxes proposed in Section 3 below):

ABSENTEE BALLOT INFORMATION

You may vote by absentee ballot if you cannot vote in person at a polling place on Election Day (April 22, 2023) for one of the following reasons:

- (1) Because you are in the public service of the United States or of this State, or a citizen of the United States temporarily residing outside the territorial limits of the United States and the District of Columbia, or you are such person's spouse or dependent when residing with or accompanying the person, or you are absent from this State because of illness or injury received while serving in the armed forces of the United States; or
- (2) Because you are in the armed forces of the United States or the merchant marine of the United States, or attached to and serving with the armed forces of the United States in the American Red Cross or United Service Organizations; or
- (3) Because of the nature of your business or occupation. This reason includes:
 - Providing care to your parent, spouse, or child who is living at home and requires constant care due to illness, disability, or injury;
 - Students; and
 - Otherwise eligible persons who are incarcerated.
- (4) Because you are sick or physically disabled (temporarily or permanently); or
- (5) Because you are absent from the district while on vacation; or
- (6) Because you are unable to vote at a certain time or on a certain day due to the tenets or teachings of your religion; or
- (7) Because you are otherwise authorized pursuant to the federal Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA) [42 U.S.C. § 1973ff et seq.] to vote by absentee ballot; or
- (8) Because you are otherwise authorized by federal law to vote by absentee ballot.

- In order to be counted, voted absentee ballots must be received at the Department of Election, Kent County Office, PO BOX 699, Dover, DE 19903, no later than 8:00 p.m. on the day of the election (April 22, 2023).
