Filing Fees are based on salaries effective July 1, 2019.

Candidate filing fee for statewide offices shall be set by the State Executive Committee of the respective political party. Candidates must file forms with the Commissioner of Election and make check payable to the State Executive Committee of the respective political party.

Candidate filing fees for County or Countywide office and members of the General Assembly shall be set by the County Executive Committee of the respective political party of the county in which the candidate is a registered voter. Candidates must file forms at the Department of Elections Sussex County Office for their county and will make check payable to the County Executive Committee of the respective political party.
