Tuesday, September 15, 2026

Who may vote in a Primary Election?
Delaware is a Closed Primary State. Only Delaware voters registered with the Democratic and Republican parties may vote in their party's primary election.

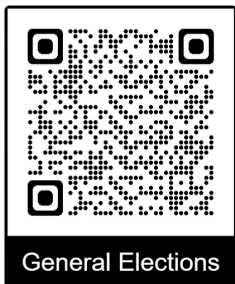

General Election

Tuesday, November 3, 2026

Who may vote in a General Election?
You must be a Delaware registered voter. Any registered Delaware voter may vote in a General Election regardless of political party affiliation.

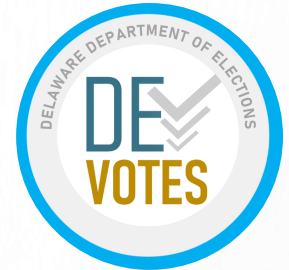

VOTER REGISTRATION

Primary Election

Voter Registration Deadline
Saturday, August 22, 2026

General Election

Voter Registration Deadline
Saturday, October 10, 2026

You must be registered to vote in order to vote in state and federal elections in Delaware. You may register to vote in Delaware if you:

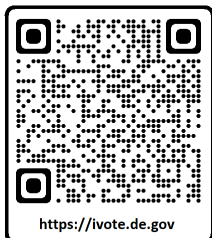
- Are a citizen of the United States; AND
- Are a resident of Delaware (Delaware is your home); AND
- Will be 18 years old on or before the date of the next General Election.

Most eligible individuals get registered to vote through the voter registration process at DMV when they apply for or update their driver's license or state identification card. Other ways to register to vote include registering to vote online, by mail, or in-person.

WAYS TO VOTE

Early Voting

Delaware voters may vote in-person at an Early Voting Site in the County in which they live during a period of ten days prior to Primary and General Elections. Early Voting Sites and schedule are posted at least 30 days prior to each election at de.gov/votinglocations, available by scanning the QR Code below:



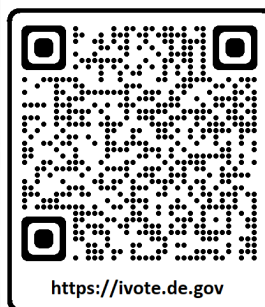

Absentee Voting

Delaware voters may vote by absentee ballot if they are unable to go to their assigned Polling Place on Election Day for a reason specified in the Delaware Code.

Absentee voters may apply for an absentee ballot online, by mail, or in-person.

Election Day Voting

Delaware voters may vote at their assigned **polling place** on Election Day. Polls are open on Election Day from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Voters may find their assigned polling place at ivote.de.gov or at de.gov/voteplaces.

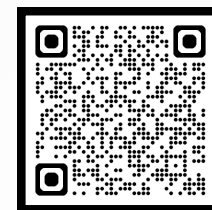

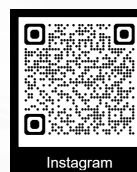
