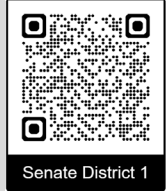

Notice of Special Election for the Office of State Senator for Senate District 1 to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Sarah McBride, and to hold office for the remainder of the term.

Date of Special Election: Saturday, February 15, 2025

Voting Requirements

- You must be a Delaware registered voter, 18 years of age or older by the date of the Special Election, residing in **State Senate District 1**. Eligible voters may vote regardless of political party affiliation. Check if you are registered to vote in Senate District 1 at <https://ivote.de.gov> or by scanning this QR Code:



- The **Voter Registration Deadline** for new voters residing in State Senate District 1 to register to vote in order to vote in the Special Election is **Wednesday, February 5, 2025**.
- You will be asked to present identification before you vote at an Early Voting Site during the Early Voting period or at your assigned polling place on Special Election Day.
- If you do not present identification, and you are at an Early Voting Site during the Early Voting period or your assigned polling place on Special Election Day, Election Officers will verify your voter registration information. When your voter registration is confirmed, you will be permitted to vote after completing an *Affidavit of Affirmation of Voter Identity*.

Voting Options

Absentee Voting (if you are eligible), including Permanent Absentee Voting:

You may vote by absentee ballot if you are unable to appear at your assigned polling place on Election Day for a reason permitted by State law.

or by calling the New Castle County Department of Elections office for an absentee ballot application to be sent to you.

- The last day absentee ballots requested will be mailed by the Department is Tuesday, February 11, 2025.
- Your voted absentee ballot must be returned to the Department of Elections New Castle County office at 820 N French Street, Suite 400, Wilmington, DE 19801 by 8:00 PM on Election Day, Saturday, February 15, 2025.
- Absentee Ballots cannot be returned to Early Voting Sites or Polling Places.**

Early Voting at an Early Voting Site prior to Special Election Day:

You may vote in person at either one of the available early voting sites during the early voting period.

Special Election Early Voting Dates & Times:

- February 4, 2025 through February 6, 2025, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.
- February 7, 2025 through February 11, 2025, 11 a.m. – 7 p.m.
- February 12, 2025 & February 13, 2025, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.

Election Day Voting at Your Assigned Polling Place:

Polls are open from 7AM – 8PM on Special Election Day, February 15, 2025. Your assigned polling place is listed on your Polling Place Card.
